趙海天藝術時間線



1940s–50s | Childhood & Early Training 1940 年代—50 年代 | 童年與啟蒙

Born in Shanghai into an art-loving family, her father was an architect, and her mother and grandfather came from Suzhou. Surrounded by works from Xu Beihong and Yan Wenliang, she developed an early passion for painting. In primary school, she was deeply moved by Picasso's *Dove of Peace*.

1960s | Education in Hong Kong & New York

1960 年代 | 求學：香港與紐約

Early 1960s 1960 年代初	Moved to Hong Kong and studied at New Asia College (now Department of Fine Arts, The Chinese University of Hong Kong) under Chen Shi-wen, Ting Yin-yung, and C.C. Wang. 移居香港，就讀於新亞書院藝術系（現香港中文大學藝術系）， 師從陳士文、丁衍庸、王己千等人
1964–69	Enrolled at Cooper Union School of Visual Arts in New York, earning a BFA in 1969. 赴紐約庫柏聯盟學院學習，於 1969 年獲美術學士學位
1967–68	Took part in an exchange programme to the University of Hawai‘i, graduating in 1969. 於夏威夷大學交流學習，1969 年畢業




1970s | Return to Hong Kong, Travel & Early Exhibitions 1970 年代 | 返港創作、國際參展和文化遊歷

Early 1970s Founded CJL Gallery and set up first studio in Happy Valley.

1972	Participated in <i>Contemporary Hong Kong Art</i> , Hong Kong City Hall Gallery (predecessor of Hong Kong Museum of Art). 參加一九七二年當代香港藝術展，香港大會堂美術博物館 (香港藝術館前身)
1973–74	Married and travelled to Europe, Australia, and Southeast Asia. 婚後，與夫婿遊歷歐洲、澳洲及東南亞，拓寬藝術視野
1975	Co-founded Quorum Galleries and published the <i>Quorum Galleries Post</i> . 與友人共同創立「Quorum 畫廊」，並出版《Quorum 畫廊通訊》

1980s | Spiritual Awakening & Iconic Series

1980 年代 | 靈性覺醒與代表系列

Early 1980s Visited the Dazu rock carvings in Chongqing, Midwest China, inspiring a deeper exploration of Buddhist imagery and Eastern philosophy.

1984–86 Created the highly acclaimed series *The Other Side of the River*.

以拼貼技法創作「新物質」系列，代表作是由兩幅縱向大型油畫組成的《生與死》




